

Human Body Project

Your human body project will consist of 2 major parts: an individual written essay and a group museum display. The essay will be worth a quiz grade and the display a test grade. It is important that you keep up with your work during this project as your group will be depending on you.

Essay:

You will be completing a 3-paragraph essay on your assigned body system. The three paragraphs should cover 1. Explain the main functions of the system, 2. Interactions with at least 2 other systems, 3. One disease or illness that affects your system. Spelling and grammar WILL count towards your final grade. Each paragraph should be a minimum of 5 quality sentences.

Display:

Your display must be a freestanding museum exhibit. People that visit your exhibit should be able to understand and interact without any directions from you. In your display you must include an interactive piece (where the viewer must DO something), explain the main functions of the system, and explain how your system interacts with 2 different systems. To create your display you must bring in materials from home or “purchase” them from me.

Additional Requirements:

In addition to the essay and display you will have several smaller assignments to complete that will assist you in gathering information. For these smaller assignments you will be given daily classwork grades. In addition you will be “paid” for completing them and then that money will be used to purchase supplies for your display. On the back of this sheet is a list of assignments that will need to be completed and how much each assignment pays. Payment will be dependent on the work and effort put in. Late assignments will have a deduction of 10% for both your grade and payment for every day late.
