Material


Part #1 is hardboard with simulated wood grain from old vanity

Part #8 & #9 are cardstock covered with laminate


All other parts are spruce cut from old plank

Notes

- 1. I suggest cutting to a length of 15 inches and trimming to a shorter length after assembly.
- 2. I used a layer of cardstock to buildup the thickness of these parts. The layer is needed on the top spacer to provide a wider space to store the sticks not in
- use, but is not needed on the bottom spacer.

Stand-alone perpetual calendar fixed tables, cardstock covered with laminate Stand-alone perpetual calendar support 0.75 x 10 (use 3 layers of plywood)

- Bottom track for calendar 0.5x 10 x 2 layers of cereal box
- Covers for unused sticks holder, 1.125 wide by 2.5 high
