
## **Convertible Childs Oak Sled – Simple Design / Basic Tools**

**Overview:** I was looking for a Christmas present for my 16 month old god daughter. I decided homemade would be the way to go so I looked online for plans, all were either too fancy or too simple. So I figured I would go with the "Seat of my pants" approach and wing it!



## **Materials:**

- 2 pieces ½" x 36" Round Wood Dowel
- 2 pieces 1" x 1/8" x 36" Aluminum Flat Stock (Runner Skids)
- 2 pieces 2 ½" x ¼" x 48" Oak (Skis)
- 3 pieces 4" x 1/4" x 48" Oak (Deck)
- 5 pieces 1 ½" x ½" x 48" Oak (Braces)
- 2 pieces 4" x ¾" x 36" Oak (Risers)
- 1 piece 1" x 1" x 36" Oak (Seat Back Support)
- 1 piece 5 ½" x ½" x 36" Oak (Seat Side Support)
- 1 piece 4" x 1/2" x 36" Oak (Angle Seat Side Support)
- 6 Brass "L" brackets
- ¾" Brass Screws
- 1" Brass Screws

**Brass Finishing Washers** 

- 8 Wing Nuts
- 6 Stainless Washers
- 8ft Natural Braided Rope

Wood Glue

Varnish

Trim Paint
